Section Reports:

West Point Fire has written tests for Tank, Class B General Knowledge, Class C General Knowledge, and Air Brake. A Committee was formed to go to Sacramento DMV to get information in writing for the Firefighter License change. The State Fire Marshall also needs to make changes. Committee members are D. Young, J.
