Treasurers Report – Reported balance of \$1,462.44. Bills going out soon for the FF academy.

Section Reports -

EMS- Pat reported 20 students finished his EMT class, next class is essentially full, he is teaching an EMT refresher in Amador in February. Sacramento is scheduling an EMT bridge class to cover items now on the NREMT exam. NREMT now has test questions on I100, IS700, and hazmat FRA, all of which are not part of CA EMT curriculum. EMSOC meeting scheduled for tomorrow night, questionable quorum.

Fire Chiefs – Discussions in Columbia College support letter; dispatch matrix.

Hazmat – FRO scheduled for FF academy; Drug Lab Awareness class at Moke Hill Fire 01/29; available for refresher classes at individual departments

Fire Training – Final academy schedule done, 1st responder in progress, 19 students now, had rsvps for 16. Upcoming trainings include- S215 (4/5-6-7-12-13) Copper; FCIII TTT (4/23-27) Murphys; S230/231 (5/3-4-5-10-11) Copper; S290 (3/8-9-10-15-16) San Andreas. Looking for addtl insured certificate for the FC class at Copper, consider using burn for post FIU investigation practice. Bill F and CALCO both scheduled a Mngt I class, Bill only has 3 rsvp'd, will likely cancel and send to Jenny Lind. Highlights the issue of non-players scheduling classes that compete with others. Skip Cavalli stated Moke Hill looking at river rescue class later this spring in conjunction with Amador needs. Angels has some grant funds to support wild land training, asked about interest in S390; discussed with the likely end of the wild land exercises in Clements should the group consider restarting our own wild land exercise similar to the old Goliath trainings from years ago. This will take commitments from all, best case would be to do training in LRAs, this may simplify organizational permissions. Will agendize for more discussion
