Fire Training – Academy continues, need to improve more districts and instructors; S215 completed with 8 students; signups ongoing for S230/231: driver operator 1B in July?; VFIS driver T-T-T scheduled for Murphys 6/8-9; Fire Control T-T-T next week in Murphys next week; CSFA workshop in Sonora this weekend, curricula repeated in Monterey 6/8-9; asked about the value of teaching separate pump operations and 1b classes, would allow to increase off road driving time
