Discussed to consider asking chief's assn. for formal liaison for coordinating the next firefighter academy, need to increase price next year, cumulative class losses of \$1,500 for this year's academy; changes coming from SFM for FFI curricula, may make current academy even closer to meeting all FF taskbook elements. The SFM is also updating Prev. 1A/1B and Invest. 1A/1B.
