**Fire Academy** – Approx 25 students in class, finishing EMR, start academy trainings in 2 weeks; happy to get help with any additional instructors, donated house in San Andreas for live burn, will need some prep work, still looking for cars for auto ex. class; PG & E offered to do safety classes for any open sessions, group agreed to leave open for now
