Fire Training – Elevator rescue class postponed due to sign-ups; FDAC meeting in Napa; CSFA R & R classes in Herald, San Diego, and Arizona, considering to offer to host one in Calaveras; FIU class in progress, Skip asked about interest in NFA juvenile fire starter class-maybe DA to sponsor, teach through County OES?; NFA course enrollment period open now.

Fire Academy – Burn building at Vallecito camp went well, looking for confined space instructor for May 3.
